Local Information

The nearest shops to Craggan are at Killin (mini-market, post office and newsagent with a garage at Lix Toll 01567 820280). A wider range of shopping is available in Aberfeldy, where there is a modern sports centre with swimming pool (01887 820 922).

Local farms concentrate on livestock rearing. Users of Craggan are expected to both know and observe the Country Code to ensure no nuisance or inconvenience is caused to neighbours. In particular, when out walking avoid climbing over stone walls and make sure you close all gates which you find closed. At particular times of year, lambing and deer stalking create particular problems, therefore please discuss your walking plans with Mrs Noble, the Caretaker.
